Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Consolidated Edison, Inc., is an electric and gas utility headquartered in Pearl River, NY. Armistead Mechanical contracted with Verticon, Ltd. to work on Orange & Rockland's new gas regulating station in Minisink, New York.

This high-pressure gas regulating station has multiple regulators, meters, substation heaters and other specialties. The project required more than 350 welds from three-quarter inch up to twenty inches. All welds were 100% radiographed with gas operating pressures up to 900 psig.

More than 80% of the piping for this project was prefabricated at Armistead's fabrication facility keeping costs down and the schedule on track.
